This Invitation for Tenders follows the General Procurement Notice for this project which was published on the EBRD website, Procurement Notices (www.ebrd.com) on 6 August 2015.

NEZAVISNI OPERATOR SISTEMA U BOSNI I HERCEGOVINI, hereinafter referred to as “the Employer”, intends using part of the proceeds of a loan from the European Bank for Reconstruction and Development (the Bank) towards the cost of **ISO – EMS, SCADA and IT upgrade**.

The Employer now invites sealed tenders from contractors for the following contract to be funded from part of the proceeds of the loan:

- ***Reconstruction of Nezavisni operator Sistema u Bosni i Hercegovini premises***

Tendering for contracts to be financed with the proceeds of a loan from the Bank is open to firms from any country.

To be qualified for the award of a contract, tenderers must satisfy the following minimum criteria:

(a) *The applicant shall have an average annual turnover (defined as annual earnings, expressed in its equivalent of a defined currency) as a contractor over the last five (5) years of EUR 2.5 equivalent;*

(b) *Experience as prime contractor in the construction of at least the three (3) number of works of a nature and complexity equivalent to the Works over the period of five (5) years (to comply with this requirement, works cited should be at least 70 percent complete);*

(c) *Equipment capacity: The applicant shall own, or have assured access to (through hire, lease, purchase agreement, availability of manufacturing equipment, or other means), the required key items of equipment in full working order, and must demonstrate that they will be available for use in the Contract.*

(d) *Personnel Capability: The applicant shall provide suitably qualified personnel to fill the required positions to manage the Contract.*

(e) *Liquid assets and/or credit facilities, net of other contractual commitments and exclusive of any advance payments which may be made under the Contract, of no less than the amount EUR 1.0 Mln for a period of six (6) months.*

Tender documents may be obtained from the office at the address below upon payment of a non-refundable fee of **EUR 200.0** or equivalent in a convertible currency.

In the event of discrepancy between electronic and hard copies of the documents, the hard copy shall prevail.

All tenders must be accompanied by a tender security of EUR 40,000 or its equivalent in a convertible currency.

Tenders must be delivered to the office at the address below on or before 30.09.2016 at 12:00 at which time they will be opened in the presence of those tenderers' representatives who choose to attend.
